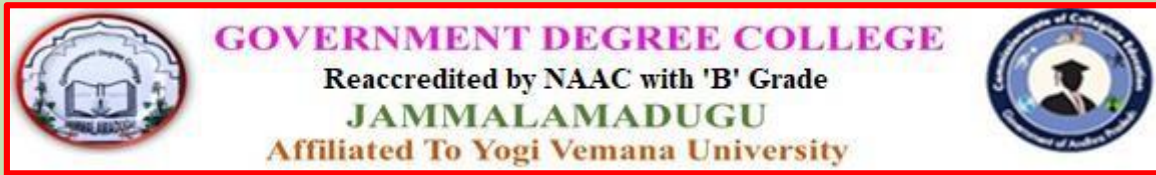

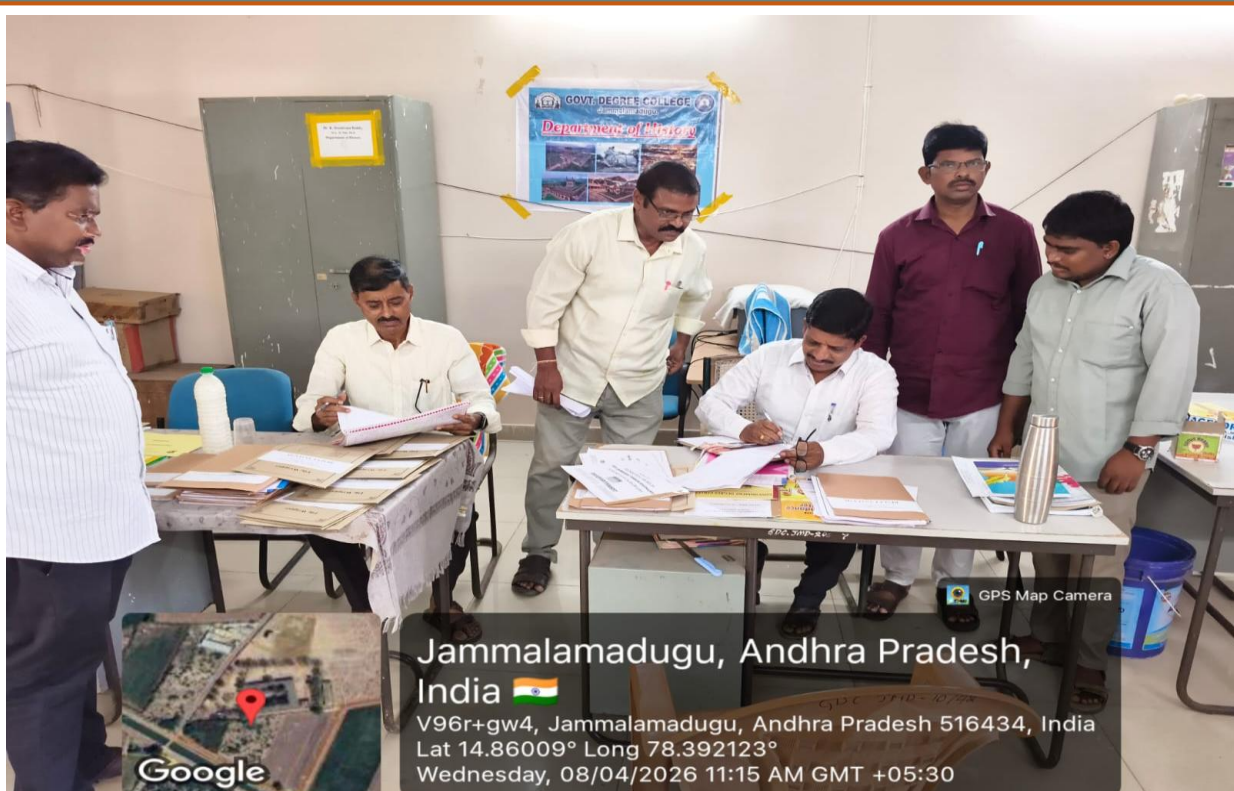
ACADEMIC AUDIT

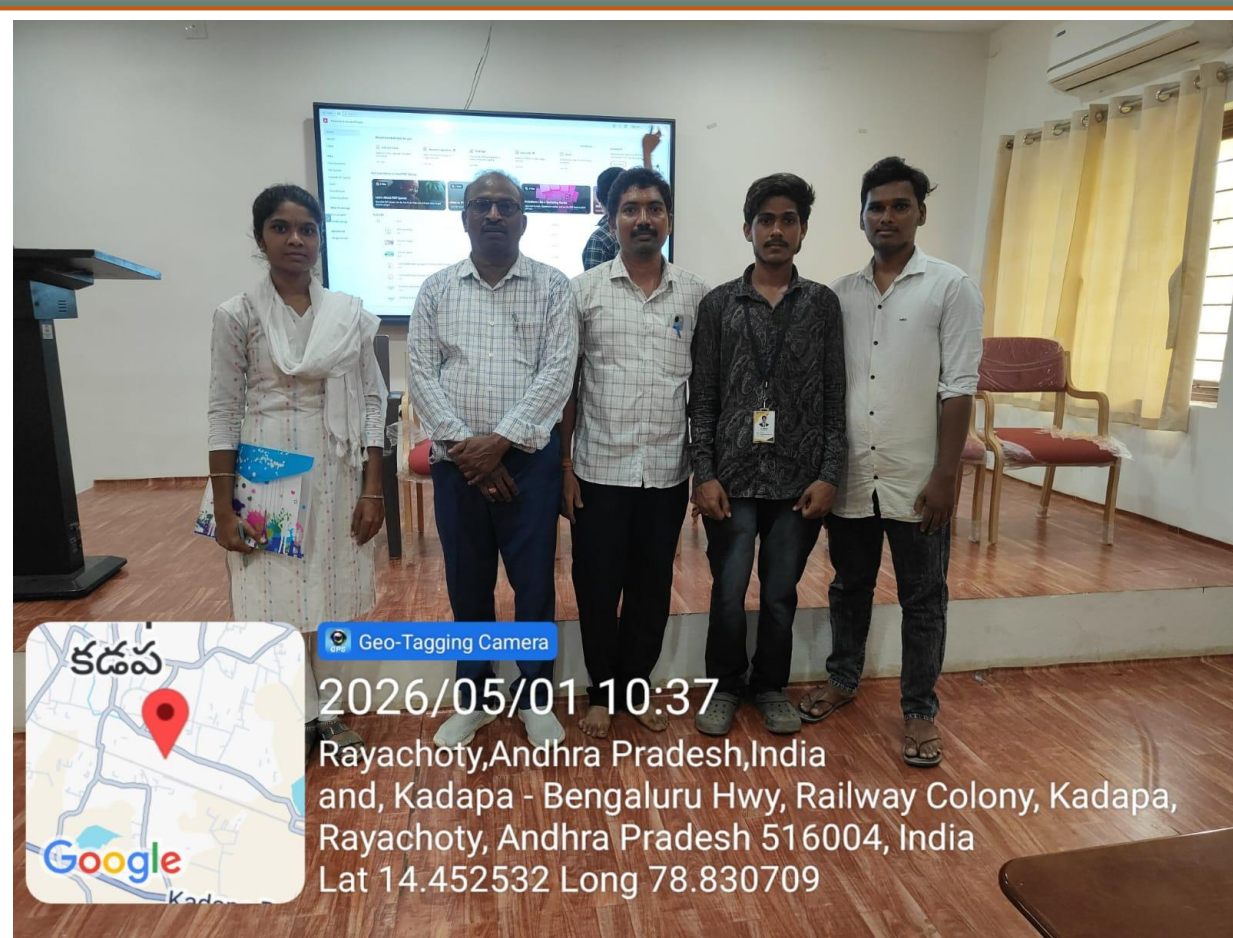
